SQA Results and Post Results Service

Despite the unprecedented situation we find ourselves in, the SQA results will be issued to pupils this summer on Tuesday 4 August as had previously been planned. Results certificates will be posted out but your child may choose to receive their results by email or text. To receive results this way they should register with https://www.mysqa.org.uk/cs8/content/secure/my homepage.jsp.

If your child disagrees with their result, they should contact their school or college who will be able to use a free appeals service. We will give priority to requests for those learners needing a result to secure a conditional place at college or university.

The school or college:

- must have evidence to support their estimate;
- can only request an appeal if the grade your child receives on 4 August is lower than the estimated grade that was sent to us.

Submissions for the priority service need to be submitted by Friday 14 August and all other appeals will be submitted by Friday 21 August.
