337 students were asked... What device do you use for distance learning?

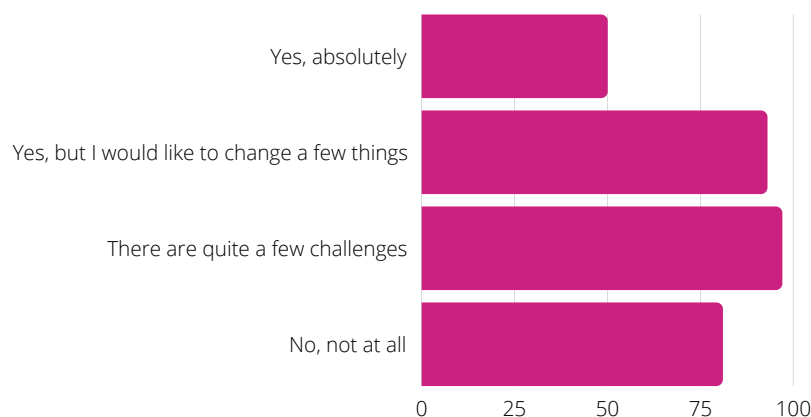


During lockdown we asked 349 students 'How well do you manage your time while learning remotely?'

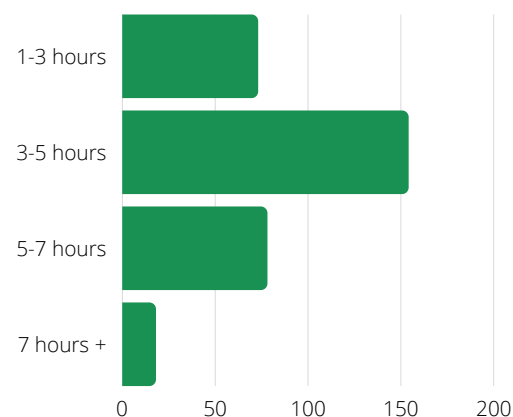


The majority of students (51%) felt they managed their time either well or extremely well.

We asked 321 students 'Do you enjoy learning remotely?'



We asked 323 students 'How much time do you spend each day on average on distance education?'



We asked 324 students 'What do you miss about being in the school building?'

Most (77%) said 'Friends'



"Our learning is helping us to develop skills to meet challenges and manage change. We are learning how to cope when we have a difficult time and understand that with the right support it may be possible to move on and be happier in the future."



With **332** students responding, the **majority** (63%) either agreed or strongly agreed with this statement.

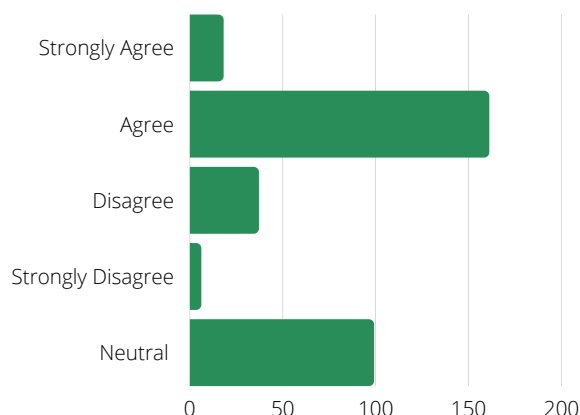
