# School Uniform, S1 to S4

We are now at the stage in our school calendar where we are looking to gather school uniform orders for collection prior to the start of next session.

As you may remember prior to last year's lockdown our pupil senate carried out a survey of what young people felt school uniform at Speyside High School should look like and the uniform options below reflect the outcome of that survey.

1. White shirt with school tie and black jumper/cardigan/sweatshirt/black jumper with school logo

OR

2. Polo shirt with black jumper/cardigan/sweatshirt/black jumper with school logo

AND

Option 1 or 2 along with: black trousers/skirt/shorts and black shoes

May I remind you that school ties are required for formal events, eg school concerts, photographs, etc.

I have detailed overleaf information about the process for placing orders along with an extract from our School Handbook about Clothing Grants.

Please can I ask you to note that orders must be placed by Friday 30 April 2021 and they will be available for collection from the school from Tuesday 10 August 2021. We will contact your nearer this time to let you know when items are ready for collection.

### **School Uniform:**

#### **How to Place Orders:**

Orders can be placed via the online iPay facility and details of this are given below:

- Log into ipay, link on Moray Council Website <a href="https://online.moray.gov.uk/site/wss/request/ipayimpact">https://online.moray.gov.uk/site/wss/request/ipayimpact</a>
- Click on school Payment.
- Input your login details and you will be taken to the iPayimpact for your child/children.
- Click on the accounts tab.
- To the right of your child's name you will see a "Select" button. Click on "Select".
- Click on school shop. You can then select which size and quantity you would like and add them to your basket.

Please place orders by Friday 30 April 2021.

## **Clothing Grants:**

You can apply for a clothing grant for your child if you are receiving the following benefits:- Income Support; Income Based Jobseeker's Allowance; Any income related element of Employment and Support Allowance, Universal Credit where take home pay is less than £610 a month, Child Tax Credit, but <u>not</u> Working Tax Credit, and your annual income is less than £16,105 (as assessed by the Inland Revenue); Child Tax Credit and Working Tax Credit with an income below the threshold for receipt of maximum Working Tax Credit, currently set by the Government at £7,330; Universal Credit with a monthly earned income of not more than £610. If you are between 16 and 18 years old and receive benefits that may make you eligible in your own right, you can apply for a clothing grant for yourself. You may also be eligible if you are an asylum seeker receiving support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999. If you are eligible and wish to make a new claim, complete an <u>application form (PDF)</u> and return directly, with the evidence requested on the form, to one of our <u>Access Points</u>, or post to the Revenues Section. You can also collect forms from any of our Access Points.
