Attendance

Senior Pupils - Study Platform - ACHIEVE and SUCCEED.

At Speyside High School we use a product called ACHIEVE as a study program, which contains course notes and quizzes for almost all National Qualifications. The company have launched a new part of their platform called SUCCEED which focuses on study skills like revision planning, creating flash cards and techniques for revision. To access this, your young person has to click on 'SUCCEED' at the top right of the page when they have signed into ACHIEVE.
